- ***Black Marble Securities Limited v. Rabie, Abou Bakr Mahmoud & Another*** [2025] HKCFI 5487 – Acted for a securities brokerage company; pursued a rogue employee for breaching his employment contract whilst defending against an aggrieved client's counterclaims for breach of duties and vicarious liability.
- ***Chan Kon Fung v. Gallop Pioneer Limited & Others*** [2024] HKCFI 1766 – Acted for a state-owned mining enterprise; successfully secured proper recognition of its investment / contribution into a multi-billion-dollar mining joint venture in Tasmania, Australia.
- ***China Citic Bank International Limited v. Li Yan Hung & Others*** [2024] HKCFI 1410 – Acted for the plaintiff bank; whether an interlocutory judgment refusing leave

to join a third-party is one which determined the substantive rights of a party and, as a result, is appealable as of right under O.59, r.21 RHC (i.e., leave is not required).

- HKIAC Administered Arbitration (2024) – Acted for the three co-defendants; successfully defended the management members of an international cosmetics company from accusations of misconduct and breaches of fiduciary duties that purportedly caused the company billions of dollars in losses (during pupillage).
